Nictaux Baptist Church COVID 19 Safety Plan

The Nictaux Baptist Church Leadership team has decided this is a good time for us to move to indoor worship. The following safety precautions will be in place for the safety of the congregation, our families and community.

- Signage will be in place to remind you of the need for masks at all time and for you to respect the social distancing requirement of 2m or 6'
- The congregants will enter the building by the North-East covered entry. (Pylons will be placed outside making 6' increments to help with social distance adherence).
- Entry will be restricted to one family group at a time into the vestibule.
- There will be an attendant in the vestibule asking questions to fill out contact tracing forms and COVID questionnaires.
- Attendees will be asked to disinfect their hands before entering the sanctuary (disinfectant will be provided)
- Sanctuary seating is arranged to accommodate two-meters or six feet of distancing
- The multi-stall washrooms will be restricted to one person at a time
- The hall to the washrooms will be monitored to ensure only one individual has travelled down the hall.
- Music will be part of our worship, but congregants will be asked to sing with their hearts only.
- People may bring cushions for seating but must take them home after each service
- Collection stations will be set up to receive weekly tithes and offerings
- On Communion weeks, Communion will be prepared by one individual with both the
 juice and bread being placed in communion cups and set out for congregants to pick up as
 they enter the sanctuary.
- Congregants will be instructed to leave the building via the main doors, one seating area at a time, with social distancing being adhered to, the Pastor will not be greeting congregants at this time.

Other Measures

- There will not be bulletins or handouts of any sort
- Building occupancy will be limited to our social distanced seating set-up
- Attendance records and questionnaire will be kept for contact tracing
- Bibles and Hymnals have been removed from the sanctuary
- Seating has been changed to hard surface chairs for cleaning/disinfecting
- The stage area will be limited, social distancing will be adhered to
- The Sound/AV booth will be restricted to one volunteer
- Microphones will not be shared or used by more than one individual and will be disinfected after use
- The building will be cleaned/disinfected after each service
